- Inspect every working face blasted within 48 hrs
- Inspect all other workings (not blasted) at least once a week at intervals not exceeding 10 days
- Daily during shift inspect working of at least one miner under his charge and satisfy himself that work is proceeding safely under every mine section
- Record findings in the log book
- Monitor and control the Mining Plan
- Achieve Mining Budget

Applicants must be prepared to undergo certain job-related assessments, if required as part of the selection process.
