MINIMUM EXPERIENCE

- A minimum of two years relevant experience required
- Trackless experience will be an advantage.
- Good communication skills in English.

JOB RESPONSIBILITIES

- Ensure that blasting wires are disconnected.
- Ensure that all areas where people travel and work are examined and made safe (All non-examined areas are barricaded-off)
- Check for ventilation flow and possible recirculation and measure temperatures and velocities.
- Ensure pumps are installed and running.
- Measure and record support pattern on Rig and Bolter panels.
- Give permission to the employees to the enter panels that are examined and declared safe.
- Maintain services within standard
- Conduct hazard identification & risk assessment
- Deal with strata conditions
- Knowledge and application of blasting products
- Ventilate an underground working place
- Determine environmental conditions (gasses, temperature, velocity, etc.)
- Declare a working place safe
- Analyse and solve problems
- Plan, organise and take control of workings
- Measure, plot and interpret measurements
- Take charge of SPMM's
- Mark service holes
- Installation of flexi bolts
- "Temporary" should be replaced with 'permanent".
 Permanent support refers to both resin bolts and Flexibolts. Secondary support refers to skin support, i.e. shotcrete.
- Anchors are used at tip excavations and brows requiring pinning. Any other support in all other areas consists of resin bolts and/or Flexibolts.
- Take charge of and drive an articulated & nonarticulated vehicle underground
- Ensure that at the End of the shift all people are out and the waiting place barrier is closed.
