Purpose of the Job:

To ensure that all repairable and rotatable materials are correctly managed in terms of supplier quality and in accordance with BPM standards and supply chain processes. Ensure the availability of refurbished material to enhance equipment availability, performance, and limit production stoppages. Expedite and ensure timely and successful delivery of sub-assemblies and repairable materials aligned with business requirements.

Be responsible and accountable for quality inspection, and initiating corrective actions related to poor quality on repaired materials received by the warehouse within the supply chain areas to ensure compliance with prescribed standards and specifications.

In addition to assess the quality

	control systems of the suppliers to deliver quality repaired or manufactured products to the mine. • To form an integral part of the planned maintenance function, as well as the procurement function when any new modifications and management change events arise. • To liaise with the engineering department on all findings to make recommendations for elimination of constraints, elimination of repeat failure events, as well as continuous engineering improvement. • To form an integral part together with procurement and engineering during all product improvement initiatives with the OEM's on problematic equipment • Warranty management. • Investigation of equipment related incidents when required and feedback to engineering thereon. • Handling and feedback to engineering on all condition monitoring reports and recommendations pertaining to corrective actions.
